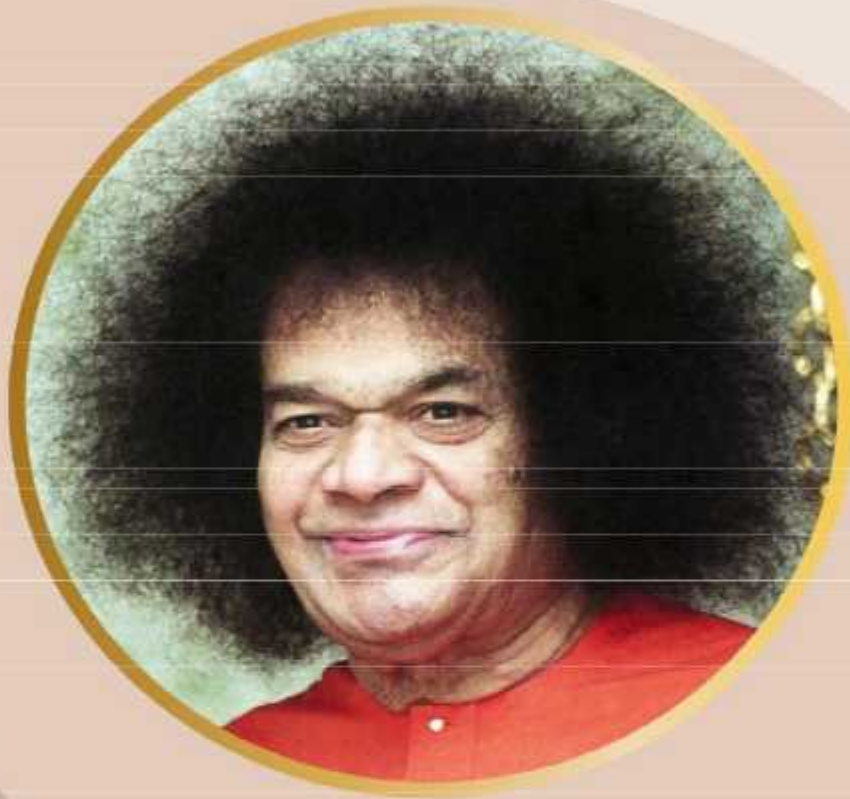

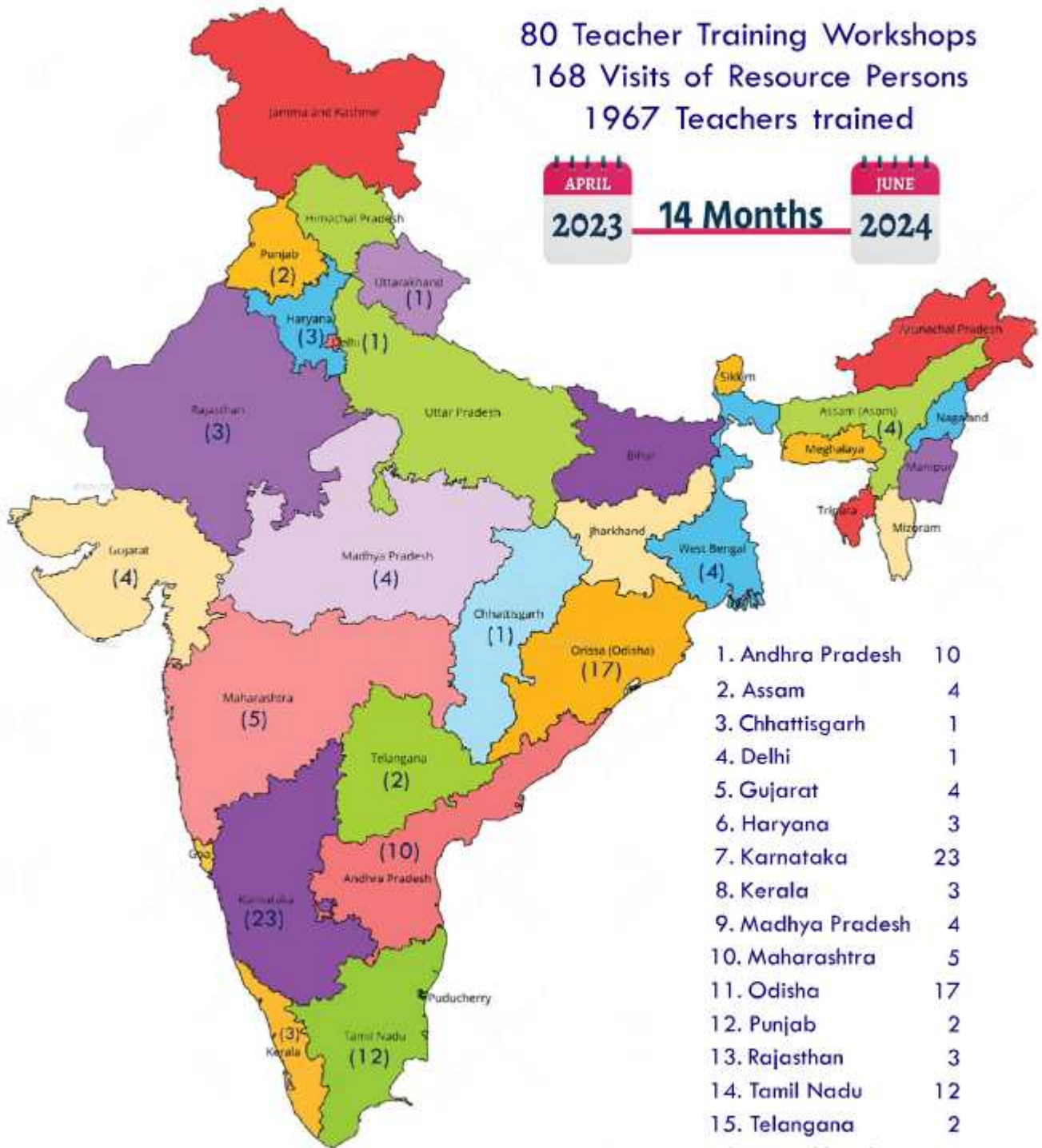

7th National Convention of Sri Sathya Sai Schools, India 26th - 27th October, 2024 at Prasanthi Nilayam

Seeking Love and Blessings from Bhagawan Baba, the 7th National Convention of the SSSNCS began on an inspiring note with a gathering of over 350 dignitaries, including principals, vice-principals, and representatives of school management from 101 Sai Schools across India. This two-day event was committed to advancing value-based education that blends spirituality with Indian heritage as directed by Bhagawan Himself.

The convention commenced with a vibrant procession featuring representatives from the participating Sai Schools, each proudly displaying placards with their school's name offering their reverential pranams to Swami. Following this, the ceremonial lighting of the lamp was performed by Sri K. Chakravarthi (Chairman, SSSGC) and Sri R.J. Rathnakar (Managing Trustee, SSSCT) along with esteemed elders, symbolizing the illumination of knowledge and spirituality that would guide the convention.

Centered on the theme 'Strengthening Sathya Sai Schools: Embracing the Sai Philosophy', the morning session featured three insightful talks. Sri Umesh Dang (Co-Convener, SSSNCS) opened the discussions by addressing the collective responsibility of educators in shaping future generations in alignment with Bhagawan's values. Sri Tribhuvan Sachdeva (Convener, SSSNCS) shared remarkable anecdotes illustrating the positive transformation experienced by teachers, 90% of whom had little or no exposure to Bhagawan's teachings before joining Sai Schools. With 1,967 teachers trained so far, Sri Tribhuvan highlighted the council's mission to extend such training to all 3,000 teachers in phases, gradually embedding the principles of spirituality and value-based learning.

Sri Nimish Pandya (All India President, SSSSO) emphasized the importance of conscience over intellect and reason in guiding actions. Stressing the vital partnership between educators and parents, he likened this synergy to the front and back wheels of a bicycle, both essential to move the child forward in life.

With the support of the Sri Sathya Sai Central Trust (SSSCT) and Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations (SSSSO), SSSNCS aspires to create an exemplary educational ecosystem that embodies Indian values and spirituality. 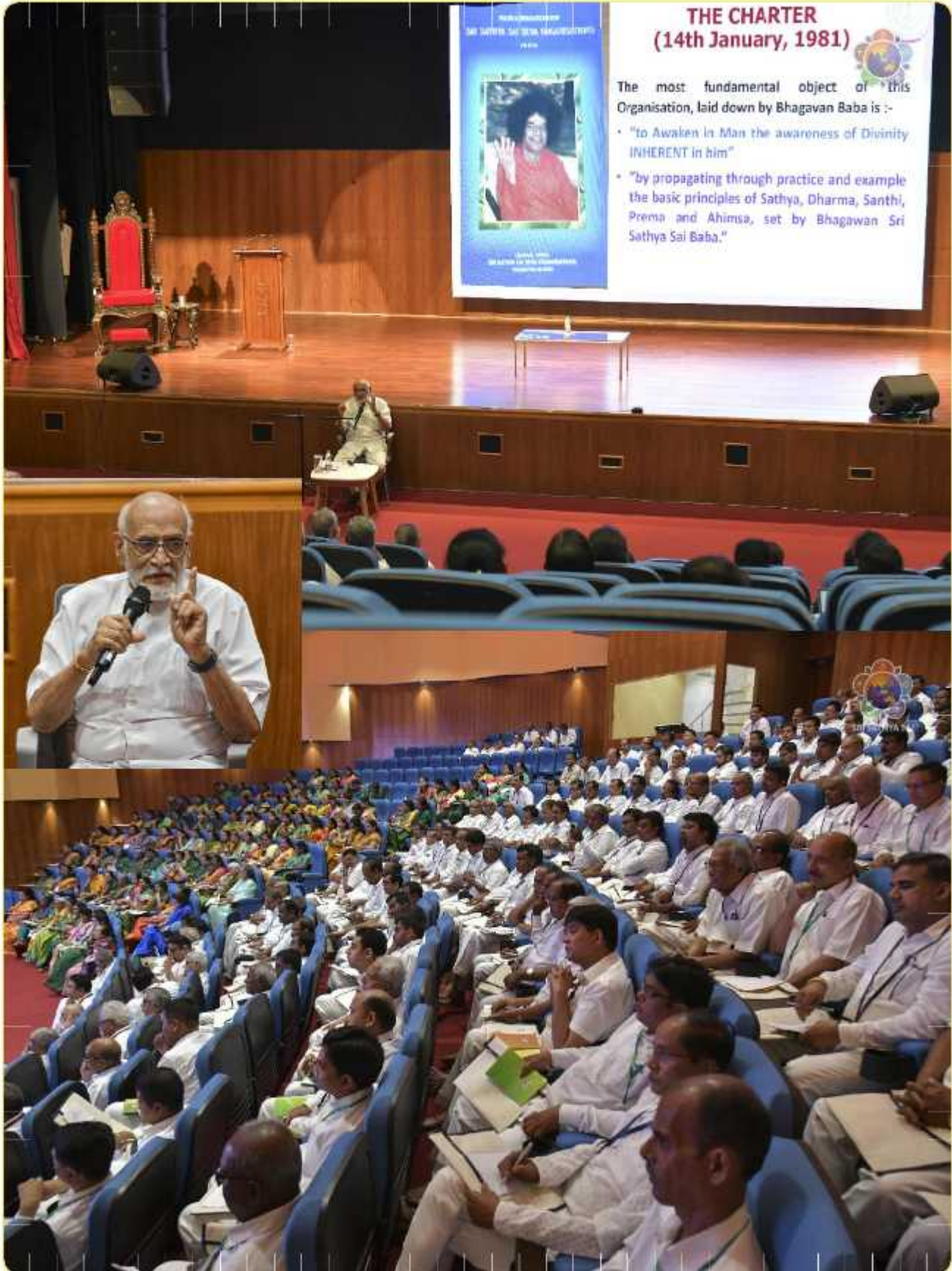

Decisions of the 7th National Convention

Date: 27th November 2024

1. Life & Teachings of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba

- To develop a comprehensive book on Swami's life and teachings for classes 3 to 9, with each chapter covering different aspects of Swami's life.
- To create Amar Chitra Katha-style books and animated versions tailored for younger students.

2. Guidance and Counselling

- To launch a 1-year online course for teacher training, with the goal of continuous improvement until all teachers are trained.

3. Research Centre for Sai Schools (IKS)

- To promote the sense of enquiry into the children leading to research
- To encourage children to read books based on Indian knowledge system.

4. Convention

- National Convention will be organized at Prashanti Nilayam, once in every 2 years.

5. Matching Grant

- The Central trust has proposed to provide matching grants to schools.
- Further directions will be provided by the Central Trust.

6. Parthi Yatras

- To be conducted regularly.
- These can be organized on a state-wise or zone-wise basis.

7. Management & Principal Training Programmes

- To implement a regular 5-day Management Training Program.
- To arrange a 9-day training programme for Principals, similar to the Diploma Course conducted for Principals in April-May 2011 at Kodaikanal

8. School management related

- Categorize schools into A, B, and C levels to address their unique challenges effectively.
- Schools to charge fees based on locality and the amenities provided by each school.



9. Value Festivals

- Value festivals will be re-instated.
- Schools with better facilities must host these festivals.
- 2-3 schools that are closer to each other to celebrate the value festival.
- To re-introduce state-wise or zone-wise Value Festivals as part of student exchange program.

10. Sai Pilgrimage / Pilgrimage to Parthi

- Pilgrimage for students of Sai Schools to continue like before.
- A request was made for the facilities like food & stay arrangements to be made available at concessional rates.
- A video of Parthi tour to be made which can be shown to the teachers to give them an idea of Prashanthi Nilayam.
- A letter will be sent to all schools from the National Council to visit Prashanti Nilayam.
- A children's festival must be organized at Parthi being the centenary year where 10 students from each school must visit Parthi.

11. Activity oriented Maths curriculum

- Not many schools are conducting activities related to Maths curriculum.
- Training of teachers will be undertaken to help them design the Activities for Maths curriculum

12. Activity oriented Science curriculum

- Learning should be Project based learning.
- Curiosity must be encouraged.
- Introduce topics with the help of day-to-day examples.
- Motivate students to take part in various science competitions.

13. Empowering skills of English usage in Sai Schools

- To encourage usage of English language within the teaching fraternity and students of Sai Schools
